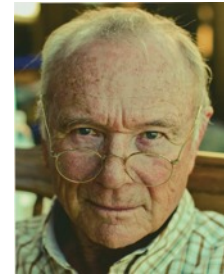
From the Race Chairman:

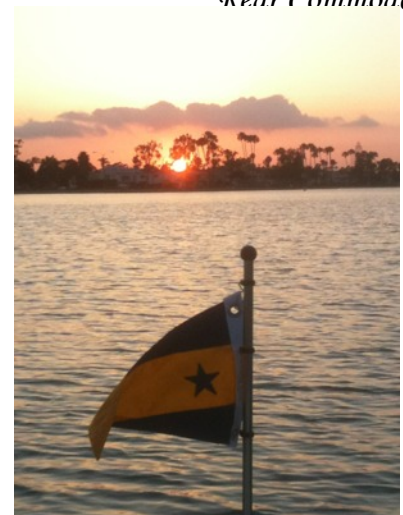

NAVY YACHT CLUB LONG BEACH SALTY SATURDAY RACE JULY 16, 2011

Notice of Race

ELIGIBILITY: This race is an invitation to boats from all SCYA Yacht Clubs, Sailing Associations, One Design Fleets which establish a class and boats racing in the Long Beach Harbor Invitational Series. All yachts must have a current PHRF certificate but there could be exceptions.

CLASSES: The following classes are invited to participate: Spinnaker, Non-spinnaker and One-Design Classes of 4 or more boats. All class splits will be displayed at the NYCLB bulletin board Friday evening July 15, 2011 or ask the committee boat personnel prior to the first warning signal. Yachts wishing to race non-spinnaker should use the non-spinnaker offset rating printed on their PHRF certificate and should put that rating on their race entry card. Non-Spinnaker boats will not be able to use their non-spinnaker offsets in a spinnaker class and double headsails will not be allowed in the non-spinnaker class.

ENTREES: Entries and a \$10 entry fee should be mailed to: Tony Rietdyk, Race Chairman, 4156 Delphi Circle, Huntington Beach, CA 92649 or to Navy Yacht Club Long Beach, 223 Marina Drive, Long Beach, CA. 90830 not later than July 13, 2011. Late entries will be accepted at the Navy Yacht Club only before the Race Committee boat leaves the long dock.

STARTING ORDER: Will be posted at Navy Yacht Club bulletin board Friday evening the 15th.

RACE SCHEDULE: The warning signal will be at 1155 and the race will be called at 1630. No yachts will be scored after that time.

COURSES AND SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: The start line will be between two marks each with an orange flag, one could be on the RC boat, located approximately 400 yards west of Oil Island Chaffee. The finish line will be located by the NYCLB facility, next to the fuel dock in Alamitos Bay bearing 110 degrees true to the Navy Yacht Club Flag pole. Spinnakers must be doused before entering the jetty, center buoys and the imaginary lines between them cannot be crossed until abeam of McKenna's Restaurant. The course chart (IF-2011) and sailing instructions for this race will be available at the Navy Yacht Club by the front door and the committee boat prior to the first warning or at our website <http://www.nyclb.com>. The race will be governed by the current *Racing Rules of Sailing* (2009-20012) except as amended by the NYCLB Sailing Instructions. Contestants should monitor channel 68 from 30 minutes before the warning signal and until after their finish. Area C "RLC" ratings are in effect.

ALTERNATE PENALTY: The 360 degree turns penalty, rule 44.2 of the racing rules shall apply. A boat shall take this penalty by making one turn (360 degree) including one tack and one gibe.

TROPHY PRESENTATION: Trophies will be presented after the race at the Navy Yacht Club, Long Beach. There will be a no host bar and food after the race.
