The 2017 racing year is over. All the results are in. Since we don't have to put our boats away for the winter, we can start getting them ready for the 2018 sailing year. The first race of 2018 is on Saturday January 6<sup>th</sup>. You just have to love sailing in Southern California!

The last race of 2017 was a light wind affair with a tour around the outer break wall, back in the harbor at Queens Gate, along the beach and finally an upwind finish. With the last race of the three race Sunday Sailors series scored: in PHRF B, Chris Mewes and his crew, on Shadowfax, finished in sixth place followed by Heinz Butner and his crew on Raptor in seventh. John Setchell and his crew, on Windfall, finished tenth place. In PHRF C, Ben Smith and his crew on Renegade finished fifth place. In PHRF D, Paul Turang and his crew on Dawn Patrol finished third in the series.

The Navy YC sail conducted the Armed Forces Day Race in May and the All Hands Race in September as part of the Long Beach Harbor Series. Navy YC boats finished 2<sup>nd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> in PHRF A.

A special thanks goes out to all of the racers who represent NYCLB throughout 2017. In the SLBYC High point standings for the best 24 race performances during 2017, NYCLB boats finished 4<sup>th</sup> (Raptor), 6<sup>th</sup> (Dawn Patrol), 8<sup>th</sup> (Renegade) and 17<sup>th</sup> (Shadowfax). Not bad for the 100 or so boats scored. Great job! You and your crews made us proud.

Tuesday Sailing continues throughout the year. The races are a pursuit style race and goal is to finish close together (with the boat you are on just to nose out the second place boat.) The afternoon sails are a great break during the week, come out for a sail with us when you have time. Most of the group has not failed at retirement! The results follow:

11/28 race results, 4 boats on course #53, 5.9 miles, wind range 8.0 to 12.5 knots; in first place, Shadowfax, followed closely by Dos Amigos, Macs and Windhaven.

12/5 No racing, the winds exceeded comfortable sailing conditions...

12/12 race results, five boats on course #18, 6.2 miles, winds in the 4.0 to 10.0 range; in first place Green Dragon, followed by Macs, Shadowfax, Fait Lux and Dos Amigos.

12/19 race results, three boats on course #49 – 6.6 miles, winds in the 4.0 to 8.0 range; in first place Shadowfax, followed by Macs and Green Dragon.


