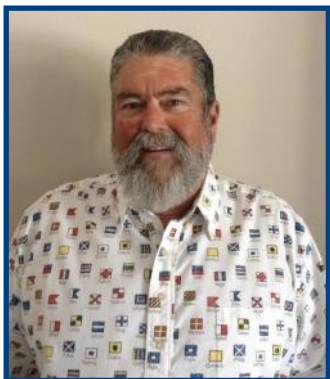

Winter sailboat racing starts on November 5th with the SLBYC Sunday Sailor Series. This is the final series in the Long Beach Harbor for 2017. Good luck to all of our competitors.

The 50th LBYC Catalina Island Series is in the books. Congratulations go out to our racers who participated in this series: In PHRF A, Guy Rosenlof, on Lodgehall finished in third place and in PHRF B, John Setchell, on Windgall finished in fourth place.

Unfortunately, the Navy Day Regatta was canceled by PRO Tony Rietdyk.

The Salty Sailors Tuesday regattas continue to be a fantastic way to spend an afternoon on the water. Come out and play with us if you have a free Tuesday afternoon.

The results follow:

9/26 race, six boats on course # 37, 6.5 miles, wind range 3.5 to 8.0 knots, in first place, Nui Kai, followed by Green Dragon, Shadowfax, Macs, AmelEden and Windhaven.

10/3 race, four boats on course # 50, 8.1 miles, wind range 6.0 to 11.5 knots, in first place, Shadowfax followed by Lulu, Green Dragon and NUI KOA.

10/10 race, three boats on course # 19, 7.5 miles, wind range 12.0 to 18.0 knots, in first place, Shadowfax followed by, Green Dragon and Dos Amigos.

10/17 race, four boats on course # 51, 4.7 miles, wind range 10.0 to 18.0 knots, in first place, Shadowfax followed by, Macs, Rosinante and Swell Lover.

10/24 race, 3 boats on course # 5 in reverse, 8.0 miles, wind range 12.5 to **23.6** knots with the wind blowing offshore at **106 degrees Fahrenheit** (felt like a furnace blowing at us on the downwind legs) in first place, Shadowfax followed by, Macs and Green Dragon.

Hope you make to the Club's general meeting on November the fourth. If not, make sure you send your ballots in.

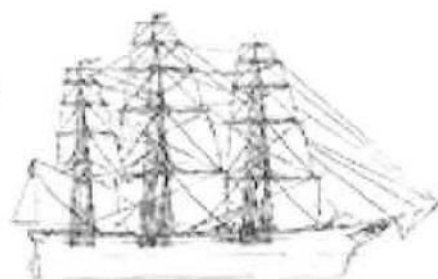

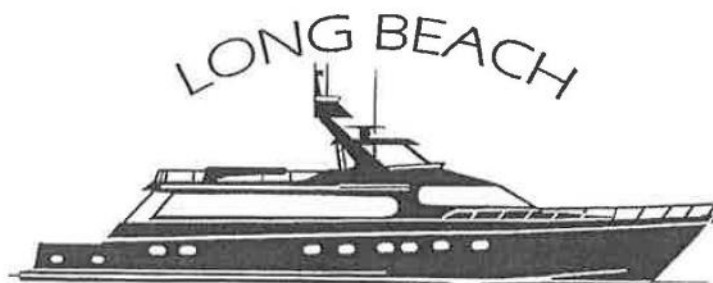
