Summer Sailing Regattas are in Full Swing!

Let's start of with the LBYC Catalina Island series, two of our members are competing in this series. After four races, to and from the Island, Guy Rosenlof, on Lodgehall, is in third place in PHRF A and John Setchell, on Windfall, is fourth place in PHRF B.

Heinz Butner, on Raptor, represented the club in the J/109 One Design Fleet at Cal Race Week in Marina Del Rey; bring home the first place trophy with three daily firsts.

Four of our members are sailing under the Club Burgee in the local SLBYC Thursday evening Pop-Tops regattas:

In series one, Paul Turang, on Dawn Patrol, finshed in first place in PHRF D with four daily firsts. WAY TO GO Paul. Ben Smith, on Renegade, finished in fourth place in PHRF C. Heinz Butner, on Raptor finshed in second place in PHRF B and Chris Mewes, on Shadowfax finished seventh in the four race series.

In series two of the Pop-Tops, Heinz Butner, on Raptor finshed in first place, with two daily firsts and Chris Mewes, on Shadowfax, finished in third place with one daily first in the PHRF B fleet. Ben Smith, on Renegade, finished in third place in PHRF C and Paul Turang, on Dawn Patrol, finished in seventh in PHRF C (the move up a class did not help Dawn Patrol).

In the month of June, racing culminated with Long Beach Race Week. The three day regatta, with seven races, was an outstanding event with ocean racing in breeze up to 22 knots. Heinz Butner, on Raptor, represented the Club in PHRF C bring home the Third Place trophy, with one daily first in race two.

The NYCLB Salty Sailors Tuesday races were the icing on the cake for the month. Following are the results from the last five races:

5/23 race, two boats on course # 5, 7.5 miles, wind in 10 to 18.0 knot range, in first place Macs followed by closely AmelEden.

5/30 race, four boats on course # 49, 6.6 miles, wind in 7 to 12.0 knot range, in first place Windhaven followed by Swell Lover, Shadowfax and Macs.

6/6 race, four boats on course # 33, 6.0 miles, wind in 6 to 8.0 knot range, in first place Swell Lover, followed by Macs, Shadowfax and Callisto II.

6/13 race, five boats (30 plus crew) on course # 30, 8.1 miles of fast reaching, wind in 8.0 to 12.0 knot range, in first place, for the first time, AmelEden followed by Swell Love, Shadowfax, Macs and Raptor.

6/20 race, three boats on course # 5, 7.5 miles, wind in 8.0 to 18.0 knot range, in first place, for the first time, Mad Meg followed by Shadowfax and Macs. See you on the water,
