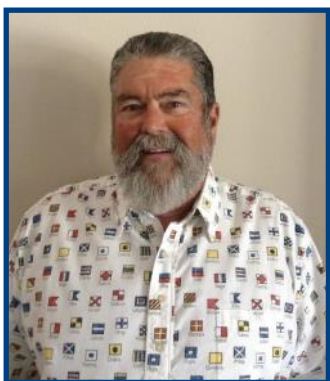

Shoreline Yacht Club held it's Dog Days of Summer Regatta on August 19th. In the three boat PHRF A fleet, Ben Smith, on Renegade, finished in 1st place; Heinz Butner, on Raptor, finished in 3rd place.

Tuesdays are always a fun day to sail with the Club's Salty Sailors fleet. The Tuesday fleet results follow:

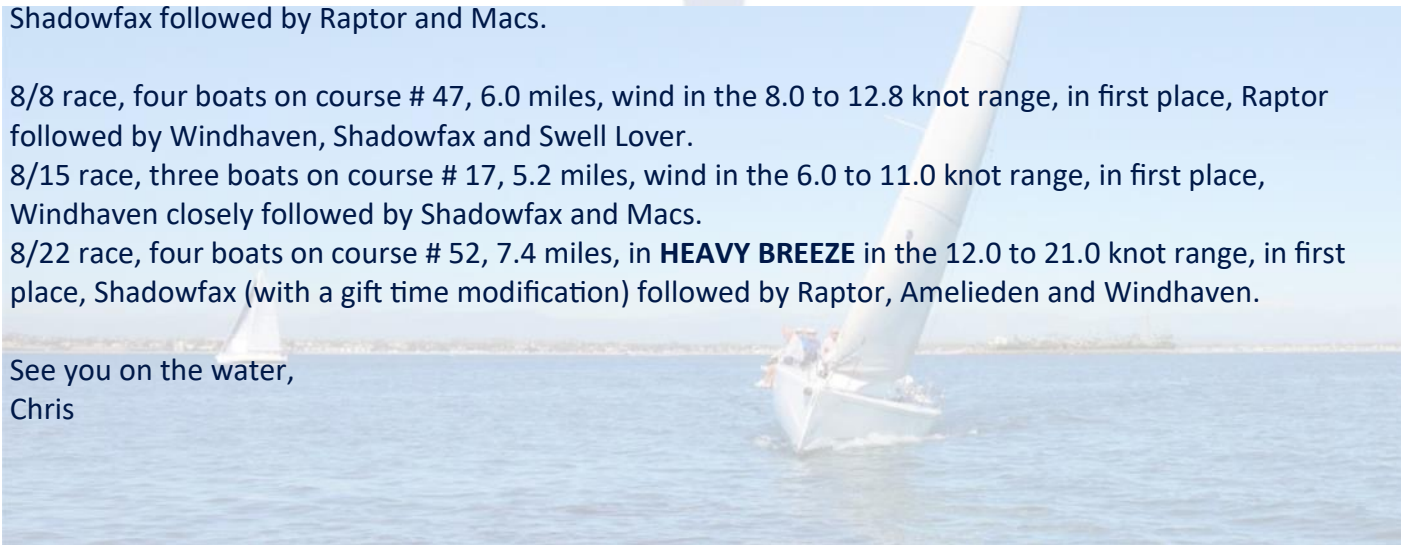

8/15 race, three boats on course # 17, 5.2 miles, wind in the 6.0 to 11.0 knot range, in first place, Windhaven closely followed by Shadowfax and Macs.

8/22 race, four boats on course # 52, 7.4 miles, in **HEAVY BREEZE** in the 12.0 to 21.0 knot range, in first place, Shadowfax (with a gift time modification) followed by Raptor, Amelieden and Windhaven.

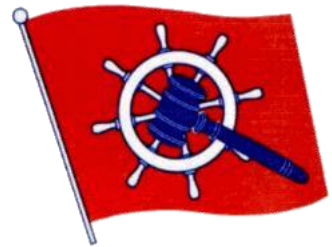

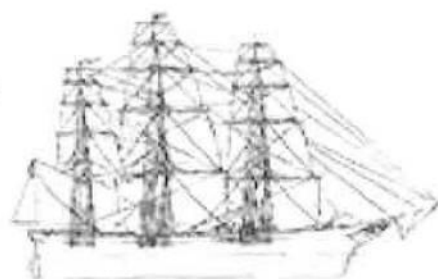

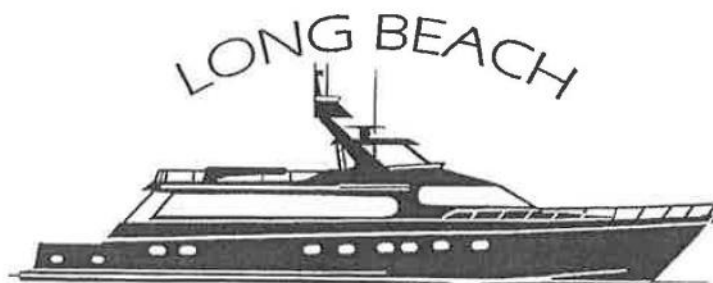
